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Location:	Lapham Peak State Park on Hwy. C in Delafield, WI, less than 1 mile south of I-94. Registration must take place prior to the start of the ski series. Race starts at the ski trailhead near the Evergreen Shelter.			
<u>Course</u> :	The distance course consists of one lap around the lighted ski trail, a 4.0 km (2.5 mi) rolling trail for High School. A 3.0 km (1.9 mi) inner-lighted ski trail avoiding the two big hills will be used for Middle School. Sprint races of shorter distances on the man-made snow loop may also be scheduled. Race course and technique will be announced on race night, or feel free to contact Mary Eloranta at 262-352-7411. A 1.2 km course will normally be used for the K-6 Advanced division and a 0.7 km course for the K-6 Beginner division.			
<u>Technique</u> :	The race series consists of alternating freestyle and classical technique races every week depending on snow conditions. Freestyle technique will be allowed on classical technique nights but will not count toward race placement awards. Any technique may be used for the K-6 th grade division races.			
<u>Classes</u> :	Students from Kindergarten thru grade 12 can participate. Boys' and girls' divisions for grades 5-8 (Middle School) and 9-12 (High School) are offered. K-6th grade beginner and advance divisions will also be offered. 5-6 graders can choose Middle School or K-6th divisions. Awards will be presented to the winners of each division.			
<u>Time</u> :	High school Boys and Girls divisions at 5:15 pm followed by Middle school divisions. K-6 th grade divisions at 6:00 pm. Please be ready to ski 10 minutes prior to race start.			
<u>Fee</u> :	Single race night entry fee of \$5 is available on a week-to-week basis. On-site registration and bib distribution begins at 4:30 pm at Evergreen Shelter and closes 10 minutes prior to each race start. Race bibs are collected nightly after race conclusion for the K-6 th divisions. For HS and MS divisions, race bibs are taken home each week to reuse for the next race and returned the last race of the series. 2024 Ski trail pass and parking sticker (state vehicle sticker or \$8/night) required
