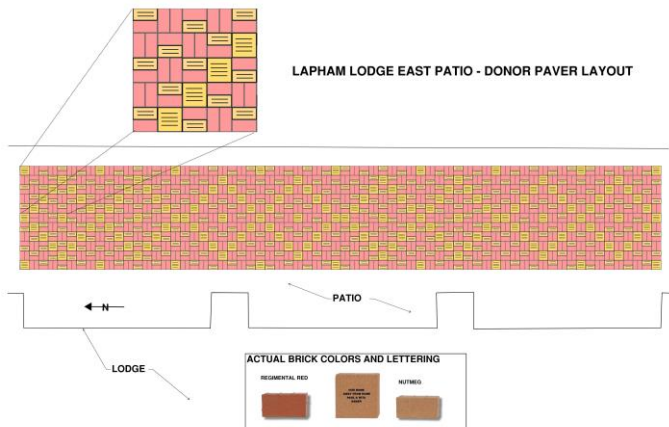

LAPHAM LODGE PAVER BRICKS

Construction of the Lodge is moving quickly, with installation of the patio expected in October.

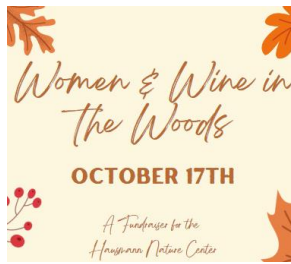
Two walls are up on Lapham Lodge as of July 3rd. Stop by and see the progress when you are at the park.

dried hard woods. 100% of the donations helps us maintain Lapham Peak's prairies and woodlands. Each in the wood racks in the park provided over 4 times the amount as you'd get at a retail location.
