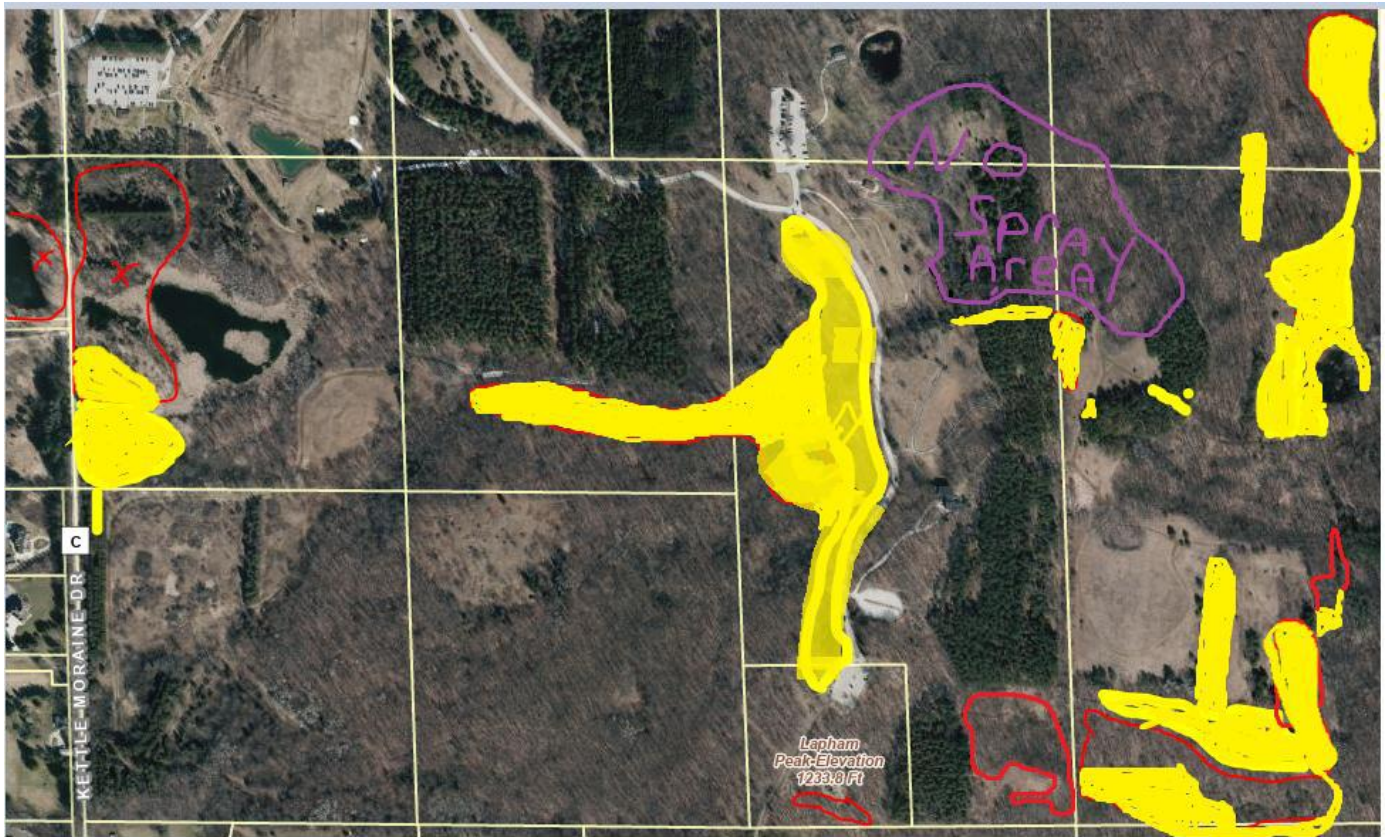
## Areas of focus in August included:
