ABOUT THE PARK

Lapham Peak is the highest point in Waukesha County at 1233 feet elevation. The park covers over 1,200 acres offering a variety of recreational opportunities.

Highlights include:

- 45-foot observation tower
- Lapham Lodge, Trecker Lodge
- 1.8 miles paved accessible trail
- About 26 miles of hiking trails
- About 11 miles groomed cross-country ski trails; 2.5 miles of lighted cross-country ski trails; 1.5 miles of manmade snow ski trails
- Snowshoeing
- 4.5 miles of mountain biking trails
- 4.5 miles of horseback riding trails
- Picnicking at two shelters
- Hausmann Nature Center
- Ice Age Trail passes through the park
- Backpack camping site
